It would be an extreme tragedy for a mother walking with her child to get injured by an errant golf ball. If you are looking for a walking trail there is a park less than a mile up the road or down in Plainfield by the water park.

Our members joined Prestwick to enjoy a round of golf and they should not have to worry about people being on the golf course that shouldn't be.
